CSA to Feature Gluten Free Cooking Demos at the Nebraska State Fair

In partnership with the Nebraska Grain Sorghum Board, the Celiac Sprue Association (CSA) will be featuring cooking and baking demonstrations at the Nebraska State Fair in the Ag Hall during both week-ends of the fair, featuring sorghum flour and cooking and baking for individuals with celiac disease. The State Fair opens August 29th and runs through September 7th. In promotion of celiac disease awareness and early diagnosis, CSA will also have free informational materials at the fair for distribution.

CSA Registered Dietitian Joan Gloystein of Utica and Nebraska Sorghum Board Executive Director Barbara Kliment of Lincoln will be presenting demonstrations on both Saturday August 29th and Sunday, August 30th at 12:00 noon. The cooking team will again make presentations at the second weekend of the fair on Saturday, September 5th at 11:00 am and Sunday, September 6th at 1:30 pm.

All of the programs last about one hour and the audience will be invited to sample the prepared finished products. They will also have printed recipes of the demos presented at the cooking and baking shows.
